Olayinka received her Bachelor's in Sociology with a minor in Government/Political Affairs from Millersville University of Pennsylvania. She then went to D.C. to work in Congress (Office PA-14-Pittsburgh) before returning to Lancaster, PA where she co-founded social impact beauty brand, Melanin Essentials.

Melanin Essentials, which was named the ASSETS 2016 Great Social Enterprise Pitch winner, finalist in Fast Company's global "Faces of Founders" business competition, and named a 2018 SVC Innovation Entrepreneur. Melanin Essentials is also leading the environmental justice movement with recently becoming a founding member in 2022 of the <u>Global B Corp Beauty Coalition</u> What started out as a congressional office role has now shifted into Olayinka's life mission to decrease the racial wealth gap in America through entrepreneurship, public policy, and community wealth building.

In 2018, Olayinka became one of the founding members of <u>Dismantle Collective</u>, a person of color-led group of Certified B Corps to name, disrupt, dismantle white supremacy and the Political Advocacy Lead for <u>WeTheChange</u>, a group of women led, certified B Corporations, and other purpose-driven enterprises. Olayinka is also leading program initiatives at <u>Common Future</u> to advance equity in entrepreneurship and shifting capital for BIPOC Communities and Local Economies. Olayinka currently resides in Atlanta, GA with her husband and three children.
